HI Ladies,

I can't believe how fast the Summer has gone by. In Montana, we can tell that Fall is approaching when the Sand Hill Cranes arrive in Kalispell on their journey to New Mexico. They arrived last week. I am looking forward to seeing many of you next week. I will be in town, playing in the Pick Your Partner game and attending the September Luncheon and General Meeting. I will be returning for the season around the 3rd week of October.

2023 Board Of Director Changes: The board elected Nancy Prentiss to fill the unexpired term of the Secretary. Please join me in welcoming Nancy Prentiss to the 2023 Board. The Board will be electing an Officer to fill the unexpired term of our TPD Chair in our September Board Meeting. In the interim, I will continue as the liaison with The Pro Shop on TPD matters and will also publish the weekly results.

2024 Slate of Officers: Our nominating committee has worked very diligently May through July and has completed recruiting the Slate of Officers for 2024. I will be sending an email to members announcing the 2024 slate of Officers October 17th in accordance with our By Laws. We will vote on our 2024 Officers in our November General Meeting on November 7th.

2024 Calendar – No changes to the calendar. I sent it out in my email in July. It is also posted on our website.

Club Championship Survey: Thanks for responding to the survey. We had a great response rate! I will share the results during our General Meeting next week. Below are the results as well as the Board's recommendation:

- 82 members responded to the survey.
- 42.68% of the survey respondents participated in the Club Championship, Sr. Club Championship or Legends Championship Tournament.
- Of the 57.32% of the members that did not participate in the tournament, 46% had a conflict on the dates of the tournament. 12.7% do not like to participate in competitions and 12.7% did not think they could compete in a gross competition.
- ~20% of the survey respondents (or 15 members) were eligible for the Legends Club Championship. Eleven of those 15 members, eligible for the Legends Club Championship, replied that they would play in the Legends CC if it were only a 2-day event (two consecutive Tuesdays).
- 59.49% of the survey respondents answered "YES" to the following question: Do you think we should eliminate the Legends Championship Flight and increase the age for the Sr. Club Championship flight to 75 and above.

Based on the survey responses and the discussion that followed, the Board voted to provide the following recommendation to the 2024 Board of Directors:

- 1. Legends Championship proposed as a 2-day event rather than a 3-day event (Tuesday/Tuesday)
- 2. Senior and Club Championship continue as a 3-day event (Tuesday/Thursday/Tuesday).
- 3. Age eligibility remain unchanged for the three events.

4. Tee boxes for each of the tournaments remain unchanged.
