- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Nancy Sartor, President at 12:39 p.m.
- II. The Minutes of the April General Meeting were approved by the General Membership.
- III. Nancy Sartor thanked the HOA One F&B staff for providing a great lunch, and Nancy Prentiss for the decorations.
- IV. Kay Cruise introduced new member Kim Seales, and Bonnie Westra introduced Maggie Etzel.
- V. Nancy let the membership know the 2024 calendar has been drafted and coordinated with the Niners. It now goes to the Pro Shop for final approval. She recommended that members put the tournament dates on their calendar now to reserve the dates.
- VI. Lisa Graff, the 2023 Catalina Cup Captain, announced that the 2024 Captain and Co-Captain are Helen Graham and Nancy Sartor. Helen asked that any members interested in playing in the Catalina Cup sign up. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the bulletin board. We will be ordering new Catalina Cup shirts for the upcoming season. Molly has a sign up for the shirts in her office. They come in different sleeve lengths. Anyone interested in participating in Catalina Cup should order a shirt. Molly is providing very good pricing on the shirts.

- X. The LPGA Amateur Chapter Championship was held on April 16, and both the overall low gross and overall low net winners were from SaddleBrooke: Connie Culley, overall low gross winner and Joan Chyall overall low net winner. Bonnie Westra and Cathe Kropp won their flights in the competition.

- XII. Nancy requested members consider the opportunity to become involved in the Board if the nominating committee reached out to them. The 2024 Nominating Committee members are Gail Plimpton, Nancy Prentiss and Yvonne LeCornu.
- XIII. The upcoming SaddleBrooke Women's Classic Tournament is being hosted at SaddleBrooke One on May 16. Lisa Graff announced we have our forty allotted spots filled, but requested members put their names on the waiting list to cover cancellations.
- XIV. The Member/Guest tournament is July 11.
- XV. The Member/Member Tournament results were announced, and Nancy acknowledged the committee and Molly Fullerton for all their work.
- XVI. Nancy discussed the transition of TPD game set-up to the Pro Shop. Transitioning this work will greatly reduce the burden on our TPD volunteers. The league will continue to manage the calendar, games, and other recurring tasks. The Pro Shop will import sign-ups from Chelsea into Golf Genius, and Golf Genius will execute the games and pairings type provided by the TPD chair. Our current and past TPD committees have been very generous allowing members to sign-up past the due date and cancel at the last minute; however, we will now be enforcing our Standing Rules about TPD deadlines, and the Pro Shop will continue to use these rules during the transition and going forward.

- XVII. Nancy opened the floor for discussion regarding the Club Championship, stating that the board was considering discontinuing the Legends flight for now due to low participation, and having the Club Championship open to members of any age, and a Senior flight for members 75 years of age and older. Nancy asked members for their feedback. There was some discussion from the membership, and it was suggested that before the board makes a decision, a survey should be done of members to determine how many would be playing in which flight in 2024.
